

# LESSON 1

## Get to know the Keyboard

### STEP 1

Look at the keyboard. What do you see? There are white keys and black keys.

The black keys are separated into pairs of 2, and groups of 3.

♪ *SIDE NOTE!*

*If you are using a piano, there is a lonely little black key all alone at the bottom of the keyboard. Ignore this lonely black key for now.*

### STEP 2

Find all of the pairs of two black keys. Remember, there are just two friends with white keys on both sides, and 1 white key in the middle.

### STEP 3

Now, find all of the groups of 3 black keys.

### **GREAT WORK, KEEP GOING!**

Review finding the pairs of 2 black keys, and the groups of 3 black keys.
